Nach muide a bhí ar bís (daltaí & múinteoirí araon!) nuair a d'eagraigh an Múinteoir Chambers go dtiocadh Danny Ó Raghallaigh ó na Coronas isteach chun na scoile le canadh dúinn. Díoladh amach na ticéadaí ar fad do cheolchoirm na Coronas roimh Nollaig san O2 i mbÁC agus bhí sé ag teacht le canadh dúinne inár scoil!




