Clós Uile-Aimsire : Multi-use games area

Cé nach bhfuil mórán cloiste agaibh go hoifigiúil le píosa faoin gclós uile-aimsire ní hionann sin agus a rá nach bhfuilimid ag obair ar! Tá fo-choiste ag obair leo go ciúin ón mbliain seo caite. Os rud é go bhfuil obair tógála an naíonra críochnaithe anois is féidir linn brú ar aghaidh leis an bplean atá againn clós uile-aimsire a chuir ar shuíomh na scoile. Cé gur bhreá linn dá bhféadfaimis páirc uile-aimsire a chuir ar an suíomh níl an spás fisiciúil ann dó. Chinneamar mar sin clós súgartha ilúsáideach nó MUGA (multi-use games area) a chuir isteach mar chlós breise agus mar áis don Corpoideachas. Tá an Comhlucht Donnelly Troy fostaithe againn leis an réamhobair ar fad is gá a dhéanamh le gur féidir linn tairiscintí a lorg ar an dtionscadail seo agus tá súil againn go dtosófar ar an obair i rith saoire an tSamhraidh. Cé go bhfuairéamar roinnt garbhmheastúcháin maidir le costas an tionsadail seo beidh praghas cinnte againn nuair a thagann na tairiscintí isteach agus beidh a fhios againn ansin cé mhéad airgid breise a bheidh orainn a thiomsú le cur leis an t-airgead atá curtha i leath taobh againn cheanna féin leis an gclós uile-aimsire a thógáil.

Although we have been relatively quiet with regard to the proposed all-weather yard/pitch I would like to assure you that planning works in relation to same are ongoing. A subcommittee has been working with the Board of Management at it quietly over the last year. Now that the naíonra's building works are complete we can move on with our plan to put an all-weather yard on the school site. Initially we spoke about putting an all-weather pitch on the site but after a thorough investigation of the school site we soon realised that we do not have enough land for a pitch. We have however decided to build an all-weather multi-use games area (MUGA) which will be used as an extra yard and a sports & PE facility.

We have engaged Donnelly Troy & Associates to undertake the preparatory work that is necessary in order to bring the project to tender and hope to get work on the all-weather yard started in the later part of the summer holidays. Although we have some rough estimates re cost of this project once the project goes to tender we will know exactly how much it will cost and we will also know how much we will need to fundraise in order to top up/supplement the money that has already been saved and set aside for the project.

Ceanglaítear ar scoileanna a mhúineann trí Ghaeilge trialacha caighdeánaithe a chur chun feidhme sa léitheoireacht Ghaeilge, sa léitheoireacht Bhéarla agus sa Mhatamaitic le linn na tréimhse Bhéaltaine/Meitheamh i gcás gach dalta i rang 2, i rang 4 agus i rang 6. I nGaelscoil Thaobh na Coille cuireann muid trialacha caighdeánaithe ar dhaltaí uile na scoile ó Rang a 1 go Rang a 6.

Céard a dhéanann tástálacha caighdeánaithe a thomhas?

Déanann tástálacha i léamh an Bhéarla agus sa mhatamaitic gnóthachtáil do pháiste a thomhas, i gcomparáid le páistí eile i ngach scoil sa rang céanna nó sa

leibhéal céanna aoise. Déanann an tástáil chaighdeánaithe i léamh na Gaeilge gnóthachtáil pháiste a thomhas, i gcomparáid le páistí eile i scoileanna ina múinteoir trí Ghaeilge sa rang céanna nó sa leibhéal céanna aoise.

An ionann trialacha caighdeánaithe agus trialacha éirime?

Ní mar a chéile trialacha caighdeánaithe agus trialacha éirime. **Sé'n aidhm atá le trialacha caighdeánaithe ná treoir a thabhairt don mhúinteoir maidir le foghlam do pháiste agus le tú a chur ar an eolas faoi conas atá ag éirigh le do pháiste sa léitheoireacht i nGaeilge agus i mBéarla agus sa mhatamaitic. Tugann an scrúdú léitheoireachta Béarla & Gaeilge le fios dúinn cé chomh maith is a thuigeann do**

pháiste cad atá léite aige/aici. Ní bhailiúnn sé eolas ar bith maidir le cumas labhartha nó scríofa do pháiste. Tugann an scrúdú matamaitice le fios dúinn cad é cumas an pháiste ó thaobh uimhreas agus réiteach faidhbe de. Nuair a fhéachtar ar thorthaí na dtrialacha (Léitheoireacht Béarla/Gaeilge & Mata) in éineacht le h-eolas bhreise a bhailiúnn an múinteoir ó bhreathnadóireacht a dhéanamh ar an bpáiste, labhairt leis/leí agus é/i i mbun obair ranga chomh maith le hobair an pháiste a mheas, is féidir leis an mhúinteoir láidreachtaí agus riachtanaí do pháiste a mheas 'sna réimsí seo amháin.

Standardised Testing : What does it measure?

Standardised Testing

Irish medium schools are required to administer standardised testing in Irish reading, English reading and Mathematics during the period May/June for all students in 2nd, 4th and 6th classes on an annual basis. In Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille we administer standardised tests in all classes from Rang a 1 to Rang a 6.

What do standardised tests measure?

Standardised tests in English reading and maths measure your child's achievement compared to other children in all schools at the same class or age level. The standardised test in Irish reading measures a child's achievement compared to other

children in Irish-speaking schools at the same class or age level.

Are standardised tests the same as intelligence tests?

Standardised tests are not intelligence tests. The main purposes of using standardised tests are to help the teacher plan your child's learning, and to inform you about how well your child is doing in English & Irish reading and maths. The English/Irish reading test gives information about how well your child can understand what he/she has read. The test does not gather information on your child's written or spoken English or Irish. The maths test finds out how well your child can use numbers for different

purposes and solve maths problems. When the test scores are used alongside other information gathered by the teacher through observing your child at work, talking with him/her and looking at his/her work, they show how your child is getting on in English & Irish reading and in maths, and help the teacher to identify your child's strengths and needs in these areas only.

Bunachar Sonraí ar-Líne do Bhunscoileanna: Primary Online Database (POD)

Eolas faoi dhaltáí atá ag teastáil don Bhunachar Sonraí Ar Líne do Bhunscoileanna de chuid na Roinne Oideachais agus Scileanna

Tá bunachar sonraí leictreonach aonair forbartha ag an Roinn de dhaltáí bunscoile, ar a dtugtar an Bunachar Sonraí Ar Líne do Bhunscoileanna (POD), agus is éard a bheidh i gceist leis seo ná go gcoinneoidh scoileanna sonraí faoi dhaltáí agus go seolfaidh siad isteach chuig an Roinn iad ar leibhéal an dalta aonair ar chóras beo. Cuirfidh an bunachar ar chumas na Roinne dul chun cinn agus torthaí na ndaltaí ag leibhéal na bunscoile a mheas, tuairiscí um chlárú scoile a dhearbhu do chúiseanna íocaíochta deontais agus leithdháilte múinteoirí, gníomh a dhéanamh maidir le daltaí nach ndéanann an t-aistriú leibhéal na bunscoile go leibhéal na hiarbhunscoile, agus do thuairiscíú staitisticíúil.

Coimeádfaidh an bunachar sonraí faoi na daltaí bunscoile uile, lena n-áirítear Uimhir PSP, Céadainm, Sloinne, Ainm mar atá ar an Teastas Breithe, Ainm na Máthar roimh Phósadh, Seoladh, Dáta Breithe, Gnéas, Náisiúntacht, cé acu an bhfuil Gaeilge nó Béarla mar mháthairtheanga ag an dalta, cé acu an bhfuil Tacaíocht Foghlama á fháil ag an dalta agus, má tá, cineál na tacaíochta foghlama, cé acu an bhfuil an dalta i Rang Príomhshrutha nó Speisialta. Coimeádfaidh an bunachar taifead ar an ngrúpáil ranga agus caighdeán ag a bhfuil an dalta cláraithe. Coimeádfaidh an bunachar eolas freisin, ar bhonn roghnach, faoi reiligiún an dalta agus faoina gcúlra eitneach nó cultúrtha.

D'fhonn chuidiú le bailiú na sonraí beimid ag iarraidh oraibh foirm POD a líonadh isteach an tseachtain seo chugainn agus iarraidimid oraibh é a sheoladh ar ais chuig an scoil gan mhoill. Coinneoidh an bhunscoil an fhoirm seo.

Pupil Information required for Department of Education and Skills Primary Online Database

The Department of Education and Skills is developing an electronic database of primary school pupils called the Primary Online Database (POD) which will involve schools maintaining and returning data on pupils to the Department at individual pupil level on a live system. The database will allow the Department to evaluate progress and outcomes of pupils at primary level, to validate school enrolment returns for grant payment and teacher allocation purposes, to follow up on pupils who do not make the transfer from primary to post primary level and for statistical reporting.

The database will hold data on all primary school pupils including their PPSN, First Name, Surname, Name as per Birth Certificate, Mother's Maiden Name, Address, Date of Birth, Gender, Nationality, whether one of the pupil's mother tongues is English or Irish, whether the pupil is in receipt of Learning Support and if so the type of learning support, whether the pupil is in a Mainstream or Special Class. The database will record the class grouping and standard the pupil is enrolled in. The database will also contain, on an optional basis, information on the pupil's religion and on their ethnic or cultural background.

In order to assist with the gathering of data we will be asking you to please complete a POD form next week and ask that you return it to the school asap. This form will be retained by the school.

An Banna Ceoil Scoile School Band



Thainig borradh faoi leith ar Bhanna Ceoil na scoile i mbliana le beagnach 70 dalta páirteach ann. Bíonn cleachtadh ag Rang a 3 gach Máirt agus Déardaoin ag am lóin ar feadh 15 nóimead. Bíonn cleachtadh ag Rang a 4,5, agus a 6 gach Déardaoin ar feadh 15 nóimead. Sa tríú téarma bíonn seisiún againn sa halla do gach duine, Dé Máirt agus Déardaoin.

Chuir muid clár le chéile don Chórfhéile san ionad Náisiúnta Cispheile i dTamhlacht. Ba é a Banna Ceoil ba mhó a bhí ar an stáitse! Tá ceangail déanta le Scoil Lorcán agus Gaelscoil na Cille i gContae na Mí, agus bíonn turas ag an mbanna ceoil chuig na scoileanna seo le haghaidh seisiúin. Bíonn idir ceol, rince agus amhránaíocht ann agus baineann na daltaí lán sult as an lá.

Beidh Ceolchoirm ar siúl ar an 17ú Meitheamh 2015 ag a 6.in. Taispeánfar an réimse ceoil atá ar siúl ag an mbanna agus tabharfar deis dár gcuid réalta a gcuid ceoil a léiriú. Beidh fáilte roimh tuismitheoirí Rang a 2,3,4,5, agus 6 an oíche sin.

Tá buíochas ar leith ag dul do na múinteoirí a thugann suas a gcuid am lóin go rialta chun é a dhéanamh; An Múinteoir Úna Ní Fhlatharta, an Múinteoir Cormac Chambers, an Múinteoir Rícheal Ní Thiarnaigh agus an Múinteoir Tomás Mac Uilleagóid.

This year saw a rapid expansion to the school 'Banna Ceoil' with nearly 70 pupils involved weekly. Rang a 3 practiced twice weekly at lunchtime on Tuesdays and Thursdays for 15 mins. Rang a 4,5,6 practiced every Thursday for 15 mins. In the third term we have a twice weekly session in the halla twice.

We put together a programme for the 'Córfhéile', which afforded an opportunity for our pupils to perform on stage in the National Basketball Arena in Tallaght. We were certainly the biggest band on stage. We have established contact with two other schools who have a Banna Ceoil, Scoil Lorcán and Gaelscoil na Cille in Ashbourne. We each host a session for the other two schools. This comprises playing a common repertoire, learning sean-nós dancing and singing traditional songs. The children really savour these days.

We will have an end of year concert on the 17th June at 6.p.m in the school to showcase the band and the various groups of musicians and individuals the school is fortunate enough to have. Parents of pupils from Rang a 2 are especially invited, along with the parents of Rang 3,4,5,6.
