The songs sung on the day included some Irish songs you might remember from your own school days - songs such as: Buachaill ón Éirne, Téir Abhaile Riú, Trasna na dTonnta, Óró Sé do Bheatha Bhaile, Mo Ghile Mear & Bean Pháidín. Although there was very little between the choirs, R4B from Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille were the winners. Congratulations to them and their class teacher Ciara Ní Bháille. Congratulations also to the 4th class pupils from St Marys, Sandyford, Church of Ireland NS, Kilternan and R4A from Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille – they were all great. 
