Lúthchleasaíocht : Seantraibh 2019

Comhghairdeas ó chroí lenár iomaitheoirí lúthchleasaíochta a tháinig abhaile le 23 bonn thar dhá lá iomaíochta i Seantraibh i mbliana. Ritheadh an lá páirce Dé Luain 20 Bealtaine. I measc na buaiteoirí bhí Alex Ní Chléirigh (1ú háit Caitheamh Meáchain F14), Aoife Ní Néill (1ú háit F14 sa Chliathrás), Ruth Ní Aoláin (2ú háit F14 sa 600m), Alice Sinclér (2ú háit sa Léimt Ard F11), Niamh Ní Aoláin (3ú háit sa Chliathrás F11), Grace Nic Aodha (3ú háit sa 600m F11). Bhí an t-ádh dearg ar na páistí ar fad go raibh lá breá gréine ann.

A mhalaírt a bhí amhlaidh leis an dara lá – Dé Luain 27 Bealtaine, an lá traic, toisc gur oscail na scamaill agus bhí na hiomaitheoirí fluich go craiceann. Mar sin féin, níor stop sé sin na páistí ag teacht abhaile arís le boinn. Seo a leanas na buaiteoirí a bhí againn – Rás tapaidh 100m F14 1ú háit Ruth Ní Aoláin, Rás tapaidh 60m F10 3ú háit Dylan Ó Dubhthaigh, Rás Sealaíochta Cailíní F10 – 3ú háit - Alannah, Ava, Daisy, Holly, Mia, Rás Sealaíochta Cailíní F11 – 3ú háit - Alice, Chloe, Grace, Katie-Daisy, Niamh, Rás Sealaíochta Cailíní F14 – 4ú háit - Aoife, Charlie, Martha, Meave, Ruth.

A huge congratulations to our athletics competitors on bringing home a total of 23 medals from the Cumann na mBunscol Athletics events in Santry. The Athletics field events were held on Monday the 20th of May. Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille's medallists were: Alex Ní Chléirigh (1st place in Shot Putt U14), Aoife Ní Néill (1st place in Hurdles U14) Ruth Ní Aoláin (2nd place in 600m race U14), Alice Sinclér (2nd place in high jump U11) Niamh Ní Aoláin (3rd place in Hurdles U11), Grace Nic Aodha (3rd place in 600m race U11). The weather was lovely on the day and was perfect for the athletics.

However, it was a different story altogether the following Monday (27th of May) when the track events that were held as the skies opened up and the rain came done in torrents soaking the athletes through to the skin! However, the inclement weather did not stop our athletes who excelled once again by winning another 17 medals: Ruth Ní Aoláin (1st place 100m Sprint U14), Dylan Ó Dubhthaigh (3rd place 60m Sprint U10), Girls Relay Race U10 3rd place (Alannah, Ava, Daisy, Holly, Mia) Girls Relay Race U11 3rd place (Alice, Chloe, Grace, Katie-Daisy, Niamh) Girls Relay Race U14 4th place (Aoife, Charlie, Martha, Meave, Ruth)

We are very proud of all of the pupils who competed in Santry over the two days, most of whom made it through to the final heats in their respective events. Comhghairdeas to them all.


