Is clár oideachais neamhiomaíoch do bhunscoileanna é Bleaist eolaíochta ESB ina bhfiosraíonn an rang an eolaíocht a bhaineann le ceist shimplí. Cuirtear an obair ranga i láthair ag an ócáid. Sé an aidhm atá leis ná fiosracht na ndaltaí a mhúscailt sa domhan mórrhimpeall orthu & é mar aidhm freisin fiosracht, co-oibriú, cruthaitheacht agus smaointeoiréacht chriticiúil a chur chun cinn ionas go mbeidh sé ar a gcumas ag na páistí freagairt níos fearr do dhúshláin sa todhchaí.

ESB Science Blast, delivered by the RDS, is a non-competitive programme for primary school classes that invites children to investigate the science behind a simple question that interests and excites them. The goal is to ignite children's innate curiosity about the world around them and aims to promote curiosity, collaboration, creativity and critical thinking in children at primary school age to enable them to better respond to the challenges of the future.

Participating schools exhibit their work in the RDS, where they receive feedback from the team of expert judges and participate in science themed workshops and shows. On Thursday 5th March a special 'Science Blast' day is being organised for Gaelscoileanna and Gaeltacht Schools. This is a great opportunity for the children to come together to celebrate their work and enjoying the craic 'as Gaeilge' at the same time!

Beidh an Córfhéile ar siúl sa Lárionad Náisiúnta Cispheile i dTamhlacht an tseachtain seo. Glacfaidh breis is 4000 páiste páirt sa Chórfhéile idir an 9 seo a bheidh ar siúl i rith na seachtaine. Beidh Banna Ceoil na scoile agus daltaí R1 ar an árdán oíche Chéadaoine an 4 Mártá ag 7.30pm.

Córfhéile is a non-profit making, voluntary organisation that aims to provide an opportunity for children in primary school to perform in a non-competitive music festival. The children that perform in the Córfhéile do so for the enjoyment of singing, for the love of playing music or participation in a play or drama. Córfhéile is about developing confidence and a feeling of self-esteem for having performed in front of a large audience.

The Córfhéile will take place in the National Basketball Arena in Tallaght this week. More than 4000 children will take part over nine separate shows during the week and the sense of achievement that they get from performing and seeing others perform is priceless. The Banna Ceoil Scoile and Daltaí R1 will take to the stage on Wednesday evening the 4th of March at 7:30pm.
