Polasaí Éide Scoile - athbhreithniú : School Uniform Policy - review

D'íarr grúpa tuismitheoirí ar an mBord Bainistíochta féachaint an bhféadfaí roinnt athruithe a dhéanamh ar an bpolasáí maidir le héide scoile. Ní hí seo an chéad uair gur ardaíodh an cheist cé acu ar chóir go gceadófaí do dhaltaí culaithe spóirt na scoile a chaitheamh in ionad an éide fhoirmiúil aon uair gur mian leo. Díospóireacht í seo atá pléite go mion agus go minic thar na blianta ag léibhéal an Bhoird Bainistíochta, Coiste na dTuismitheoirí agus Foirne. Tá an-chuid plé agus machnamh déanta ag an mBord le cúpla mí anuas ar an bpolasáí Éide Scoile. Bunaíodh fochoiste de bhaill an Bhoird chun dul i mbun taighde agus athbhreithniú.

Mar Bhord táimid an-bhródúil as an éide scoile galánta atá againn i Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille. Creidimid go gcuireann an éide le bród na scoile agus go gcuireann sé leis an mothú a fhaigheann na daltaí go bhfuil siad tábhachtach agus gur cuid d'fhoireann iad. Measaimid go bhfuil tionchar dearfach ag an éide ar thimpeallacht na scoile, laistigh agus lasmuigh den seomra ranga. Léiríonn staidéir, nuair a bhíonn gach duine gléasta mar an gcéanna go mbraitheann daltaí bródúil as a bheith mar chuid dá scoil agus go dtreisíonn sé meanma na scoile. Mothaíonn na daltaí ceangail níos mó le pobal na scoile agus bíonn siad níos bródúla as an scoil dá bharr. Cuireann sé seo go mór le spiorad na scoile.

Ghlac an Bord an cinneadh nach mbeadh aon mhór athraithe á dhéanamh ar an bpolasáí éide scoile ach go gcuirí roinnt mionathruithe i bhfeidhm chun tuilleadh rogha a thabhairt do thuismitheoirí agus daltaí na scoile.

The Board of Management were asked by a group of parents to look into the possibility of making changes to the school uniform policy. The debate over whether pupils should be allowed to wear the school tracksuit instead of the formal uniform whenever they wish is one that has been debated over the years at Board of Management, Coiste na dTuismitheoirí and Staff level. The Board has had a great deal of discussion and reflection on the School Uniform Policy over the last few months. A sub-committee of Board members was established to undertake research and review of same.

As a Board we are very proud of the very smart school uniform we have in Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille. We believe that the uniform enhances school pride and contributes to a sense of belonging as pupils are made to feel important and as if they are part of a team by wearing the uniform. We feel that the uniform has a positive impact on the school environment, both inside and outside of the classroom. Studies show that when everyone is dressed the same and feels proud to be a part of their school, it boosts morale. The pupils have a greater sense of togetherness and pride, boosting school spirit.

After much discussion the Board decided that there would be no major changes to the school uniform policy but that a number of minor modifications would be implemented to give more choice to parents and pupils of the school.

Éide Scoile School Uniform

As seo amach beidh an rogha ann léine 'polo' bán a chaitheamh in ionad an léine nó an blús bán.

Beidh sé roghnach an carbhat a chaitheamh nó gan é a chaitheamh.

Beidh cead freisin bróga reatha dubh nó dúghorm nó bróga leathair dubh/dúghorm a chaitheamh leis an éide scoile (rogha bróga reatha bán/dubh/dúghorm a chaitheamh leis an gculaithe spóirt).

Ní mór do pháistí ó R1 – R6 an t-éide scoile cheart a chaitheamh ar scoil gach lá agus an chulaith spóirt a chaitheamh na laethanta go mbíonn rang corpoideachais acu.

Is féidir le cailíní bríste dúghorm a chaitheamh má theastaíonn uatha. Bhí

sé seo ceadaithe i gcónaí

Tá sé de rogha ag na Naónáin an t-éide scoile nó an chulaith spóirt a chaitheamh. Níl aon athrú ar seo.

Maidir leis an éide scoile samhraíd (bríste gearr dúghorm agus 'polo' bán) tá cead ag na páistí í seo a chaitheamh cheana féin trí mhí in aghaidh na bliana, Meán Fómhair, Bealtaine & Meitheamh, i rith tréimhsí dea-aimsire. Mothaíonn an Bord go bhfuil sé seo leordóthanach agus nár cheart síneadh a chur leis seo.

From now on there will be the option of wearing a white 'polo' shirt instead of the white shirt or blouse.

Wearing of the school tie is optional.

Black or navy running shoes or black / navy blue leather shoes will also be

allowed with the school uniform (choice of white / black / navy running shoes with the sports suit).

Children from R1 - R6 must wear the correct school uniform to school every day and the sports uniform on the days they have a physical education class.

Girls can wear navy trousers should they wish to do so - this has always been the case.

Infants have the option of wearing the school uniform or sports suit. No change here.

For the summer school uniform (navy shorts and white 'polo') the children are already allowed to wear this three months a year, September, May and June, during periods of good weather. The Board feels that this is sufficient and should not be extended.

Saolré an Feileacán

1. Beireann an feileacán ubh ar dhuileog chabáiste.

 3. Itheann an chruimh go leor agus fásann sé.
 4. Tar éis cúpla seachtain athraíonn an cruimh isteach ina chrisilid.
 1. Tar éis 2-3 seachtain osclaíonn an crisilid & tagann an feileacán amach.

Tá R4 ar bíos ag fanacht ar na feileacáin le teacht amach.!

Life Cycle of the Butterfly

1. *The butterfly lays her eggs on a cabbage leaf.*
 2. *A caterpillar bursts out of the egg*
 3. *The caterpillar eats a lot and grows and grows.*
 4. *After a few weeks the caterpillar changes into a chrysalis.*
 5. *After 2-3 weeks the chrysalis opens and the butterfly emerges.*

R4 are excitedly waiting for the butterflies to come out!
