Comórtas Póstaeir Gaeilge Poster Competition

Cuireadh comórtas póstaeir Gaeilge ar siúl do dhaltaí R3 go R6 leis an nGaeilge a chur chun cinn agus le meas don teanga a mhúscailt agus a threisiú i measc na ndaltaí. Iarraidh ar na daltaí teachtaireachtaí dearfacha faoin nGaeilge nó nathanna cainte deasa Gaeilge a chur i láthair i bhfoirm póstaeir. Bhí an-chaighdeán do deo le feiceáil san obair a rinne na páistí ar fad agus bhí sé fíor-dheacair buaiteoirí a roghnú as gach rang. É sin ráite roghnaíodh dhá phóstaeir as gach rang agus bronnadh T-léine Gaeilge ar na daltaí sin mar dhuais. Tá na póstaeir ar fad ar crochadh thart faoin scoil agus na póstaeir is fearr crochta ar an mballa sa halla áit gur féidir leis na páistí ar fad sa scoil iad a fheiceáil. We held a poster competition for the pupils of R3 to R6 to promote the Irish language and to reinforce the children's pride in their native tongue. The pupils were asked to create posters with a positive message about the Irish language or to illustrate a nice Irish language phrase in poster form. The standard was very high and narrowing down the winners in each class was extremely difficult to do. That said, 2 posters from each class were chosen and the winners were presented with Irish language T-shirts. It's great to hear parents speaking Irish around the school. Obviously as parents are asked not to enter school ground due to Covid-19 protocols, it is the parents of the junior and senior infants and the parents of the náionra who can be heard speaking Irish around the school. Please continue with this good practice. It helps and supports us in our work as we encourage our pupils to speak Irish as a natural means of communicating with each other outside the classroom. For those who speak little or no Irish, I urge you to give it a try - start with the greetings such as 'Dia Duit', 'Conas atá tú?', 'Slán leat,' 'Bíodh lá deas agat' etc. and your Irish and your confidence to speak it will come back to you.

Thanks to everyone who supported Goal Jersey day on Friday 8 October. €1,078 was raised for Goal on the day (€128 collected from the sale of unclaimed items of school uniform was added to the donations collected on the day).


