Rinne Urdd Gobaith Cymru teagmhál le Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille féachaint an mbeadh suim ag an scoil páirt a ghlacadh ina gclár Breatnaise agus Cultúir. Is é Urdd Gobaith Cymru (Urdd) an eagraíocht óige náisiúnta is mó sa Bhreatain Bheag agus cuireann sé spóirt, ealaíon, obair dheonach, printiseacht, caitheamh aimsire allamuigh, deiseanna daonnúla, idirnáisiúnta agus cónaithe ar fáil do phaistí agus do dhaoine óga ar fud na Breataine Bige a threisíonn a bhféinmhuijnín agus a chuireann ar a gcumas cur go dearfach lena bpobal agus leis an domhan mór.

Ó bunaíodh é i 1922, tá breis is ceithre mhiliún páiste agus duine óg ina mbaill den għluuiseach agus chothaigh sé na glúnta daoine óga le bheith bródúil as a dtír, oscailte do dhaoine eile agus ina gcorpráidí beo dá dteanga agus dá gcultúr. Tá sé mar aidhm ag Urdd Gobaith Cymru an Bhreatnais a bheith mar teanga beo i measc páistí agus daoine óga sa Bhreatain Bheag agus cur lena n-úsáid den Bhreatnais.

Bhí foireann an Urdd sa scoil an tseachtais seo chaite ag obair le R5A & R5B. B'í aidhm na cuairte ná a gcultúr agus a dteanga a roinnt leo. Reachtáil siad seisiúin Spórt & Cultúir leis an dá rang thar 2 lá. Chuir siad an clár 'Chwarae yn Gymraeg' nó 'Ag Imirt tré Bhreatnais' ar bun leis na páistí agus is i mBheatnais amháin a reachtáileadh na seisiúin spraoi sin (tumoideachas). Bhí dhá lá thar a bheith taitneamhach, gníomhach, spraoiúil ag na páistí agus bhaineadar an-sult go deo as an eispéaras.

Thug Aire Oideachais na Breataine Bige, Mr Jeremy Miles cuairt ar an scoil ar an gCéadaoin 01 Mártas, Lá Naomh Daithí - Lá Féile Náisiúnta na Breataine Bige. Bhí sé an-tógha leis an gclár teanga/tumoideachais atá bhí ar bun sa scoil agus bhain sé an-taitneamh as bualach leis na páistí agus iad a fheiscint ag foghlaim Breatnaise. Léirigh sé an-spéis freisin sa Ghaelscolaíocht agus an-spéis aige foghlaim faoin obair a déantar 'sna Gaelscoileanna agus in Éirinn go coitianta leis an nGaeilge a chur chun cinn.

Chwarae yn Cymraeg - Playing through Welsh

Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille was approached by Urdd Gobaith Cymru to see if the school would be interested in participating in their Welsh language & Culture outreach programme. Urdd Gobaith Cymru ([Urdd](#)) is Wales' largest national youth organisation and provides sports, arts, volunteering, apprenticeship, outdoor pursuits, humanitarian, international and residential opportunities for children and young people through the Welsh language that builds their self-confidence and enables them to make a positive contribution to their community and the wider world.

Since it was established in 1922, over four million children and young people have been members of the movement and it has nurtured generations of young people to be proud of their country, open to others and living embodiments of the Welsh language and culture. Urdd Gobaith Cymru aims to bring the Welsh language alive for children and young people in Wales and to increase their use of Welsh.

The Urdd team were in the school last week working with R5A & R5B. The aim for their visit was to share some aspects of the Welsh culture and language with our pupils. They held Sports & Culture sessions with both classes over the 2 days. These sessions come under the banner 'Chwarae yn Gymraeg' (Playing through Welsh) and these sessions were conducted solely through Welsh (total immersion). The pupils enjoyed two very engaging, active, fun-filled days and thoroughly enjoyed the whole experience.

The Welsh Minister for Education & the Welsh Language, Mr. Jeremy Miles visited the school to see the project in action on Wednesday the 1st of March - which coincided with St.David's Day - the day the Welsh people celebrate their patron Saint.

He was very impressed with how the language/immersion program was being implemented in our the school and he was very pleased to meet the children and see them learning Welsh. He was extremely interest in learning about the Irish education system and was keen to hear about the work that is done in Gaelscoileanna and in Ireland in general to promote the Irish language.

The icing on the cake for the pupils in R5 was being featured on Nuacht TG4 that evening and also in the Irish Independent & The Irish Times (on-line) the following day!!



Traffic Management ONE-WAY SYSTEM

Tá córas tráchta aon slí i bhfeidhm againn ar an mbóthar lasmuigh de láthair na scoile & laistigh de gheataí na scoile. Cuireadh i bhfeidhm é go priomha leis an ngluaiseacht tráchta a eascú agus le sábháilteachta bpáistí a chinntí agus iad ag turlaingt as na carranna.

- Tá dhá gheata scoile ann: An geata ISTEACH & an geata AMACH. Tiomáin isteach an geata is faide uait (an dara gheata) & amach an geata is cóngarái do Bheallairmín (an chéad gheata)
- Gluaiseann na carranna ar fad san aon treo amháin ón uair go dtrasnaíonn siad céad gheata na scoile.
- Gluaiseann na carranna ar fad thar an chéad gheata, isteach an dara gheata agus amach an chéad gheata arís.

Cialláonn sé seo gur féidir leis an trácht gluaiseacht go héasca gan dul i ngleic le carranna atá ag gluaiseacht sa mhalaire treo.

We operate a one-way system on the roadway directly outside the school and inside in the school grounds. It was put in place primarily to facilitate the flow of traffic and to ensure the safety of the children as they disembark from cars.

- There are two gates to the school. One entrance gate (ISTEACH) & one exit gate (AMACH).
- Enter by the furthest gate (the 2nd gate) and exit by the gate nearest to Belarmino Estate (the 1st gate).
- On passing the first school gate all cars travel in the same direction (one-way in operation).
- All cars travel past the first gate, in the second gate and out the first gate to leave the area again.

This allows traffic to flow without having to contend with drivers making u turns or cars driving in the opposite direction.

PARKING on School Grounds

Parking in the car parking spaces to the front of the school is reserved for school staff only. Parents/minders may park in the parking spaces (24) beside the basketball courts. Park only in designated areas. Do NOT park on footpaths or grass verges.

Córas Tuirlingthe Tá córas tuirlingthe i bhfeidhm ionas gur féidir le tuistí tiomáint isteach ar láthair na scoile, daltaí a scaoileadh amach as an gcarr agus tiomáint ar aghaidh amach geata na scoile arís. Ceadaítear do charranna stopadh go sealadach chun tosaigh ar ionaid páirceála na foirne le páistí a scaoileadh amach (cosán coisithe marcálte ar an mbóthar).

Scoitheadh Coiscithe Níor cheart d'aon charr tiomáint thar charr eile ar fhearrann na scoile - Is ceart fanacht i scúnne go mbíonn an carr os comhar réidh le bogadh ar aghaidh.

Caithfidh gach duine atá ag tiomáint nó ag páirceáil ar láthair na scoile a bheith airdealach & súil a choiméad amach don pháiste a d'fhéadfadh rith nó siúl amach os comhair an chairr gan choinne.

Níl sé ceadaithe páirceáil dúbalta a dhéanamh os comhair na scoile, ar feadh tréimhse ama ar bith.

Trasnú Coisithe Baintear an-úsáid as an dá thrasnú coisithe atá ar fhearrann na scoile. Is gá d'éinne atá ag tiomáint & ag páirceáil sa scoil aire agus cúram ar leith a thabhairt agus iad ar láthair na scoil agus súil a choinneáil amach do pháistí i gcónaí.

Iarraim ar thuismitheoirí cúrsaí sábháilteachta bóthar a phlé leis na páiste(i) sa bhaile.



Family Challenge

We are setting you some family challenges as part of our Seachtain na Gaeilge school events! We have set three challenges per family, one for Monday, one for Tuesday and another for Wednesday.

The pupils have the choice of having normal homework each night or completing the Family Challenge!

Homework or Family Challenge

If a pupil completes a family challenge as homework they will receive a point for the class.

If the class manages to achieve > 30 points the class will receive a homework pass that they can use on 1 day next week.

If the class manages to achieve > 45 points the class will receive 2 homework passes that they can use on 2 days next week.

>30 Class Points = 1 Class Homework Pass

>45 Class Points = 2 Class Homework passes

>55 Class Points = 3 Class Homework Passes

Record a short clip of family speaking Gaeilge at the table - It can be people introducing yourselves, telling us what's on the menu.....or anything else 'as Gaeilge'

(same clip will suffice for each sibling)

2. Tuesday's Challenge

Voice Message 'as Gaeilge'

Record a voice message as Gaeilge on your mobile phone

Leave a message in the stream in your child's Google Classroom to confirm that you have done so.

We will be making random calls on Wednesday to parent's mobile phones in the hope that the phone will be answered as Gaeilge with a 'Dia Dhuit' or if it goes to the answer machine that will hear a message as Gaeilge!

3. Wednesday's Challenge

Sing a Song 'as Gaeilge'

Family to sing a verse/chorus of one of the following songs
