

Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille & Ysgol Gymraeg Morswyn



R6A le Daltaí Ysgol Gymraeg Morswyn: Porth Dafarch, Anglesey, An Bhreatain Bheag

Thug rang ó Ysgol Gymraeg Morswyn, i Holyhead sa Bhreatain Bheag cuairt lae ar Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille ar an gCéadaoin seo chaite 11 Deireadh agus chuaigh R6A ar cuairt go Holyhead an Mháirt 17 Deireadh Fómhair agus chaith siad an lá ag gabháil d'imeachtaí spraoiúla lena gcairde nua ó Ysgol Cymraeg Morswyn.

Bunaíodh an nasc idir an Ysgol Gymraeg Morswyn agus Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille thiar i 2005 agus tá cuairt bliaintiúil á thabhairt again ar scoileanna a chéile ó shin. Gan dabht chuir 'blianta Covid' stop lenár dtaisteal ach tá áthas an domhan orainn gur éirigh linn na cuairteanna a athosú arís i mbliana.

Foghlamaíonn na daltaí sad á scoil dá ghrúpa an-chuid óna chéile agus feiceann siad go bhfuil daltaí i dtír eile atá ag freastal ar 'ghaelscoil' cosúil leo féin agus nach bhfuil sé sin chomh 'hait' nó chomh 'neamhchoitianta' is a cheapann roinnt daoine. Feiceann siad freisin go bhfuil go leor de na bun luachanna agus na haidhmeanna céanna á chur chun cinn sa dá scoil; béim ar an dteanga, ar an gceol, ar an gcultúr, ar an traidisiún agus gach a bhaineann léi. Eispéreas iontach é seo do na páistí a mhaireann ina gcumhni i bhfad tar éis dóibh an bhunscoil a fhágáil agus níos faide.

A class from Ysgol Gymraeg Morswyn, in Holyhead Wales visited Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille on Wednesday last 11th October and R6A made a return visit to their school in Holyhead on Tuesday and spent the day participating in fun-activities with their new friends.

The partnership between Ysgol Gymraeg Morswyn and Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille was established way back in 2005 and we have been visiting each other's schools annually since then. We are delighted to have been able to re-establish the visits after a short 'Covid enforced' break.



The children learn a lot from the experience and from each other. They see that there are children in other countries who attend 'gaelscoileanna' like themselves and that it is not as 'odd' or unusual, as some people see it. They also see that there are many similarities between the two schools; in particular the emphasis that is placed on our native language, music, culture, traditions and all that goes with it. This is a wonderful experience for the pupils in both schools and one they remember fondly long after they have left primary school and beyond.



Ysgol Gymraeg Morswyn

'Gaelscoil Breatnaise' is ea Ysgol Gymraeg Morswyn atá lonnaithe ar Oileán Anglesey sa Bhreatain Bheag. Scoil tumoideachais Breatnaise í agus cosúil linn féin is í an Bhreatnais an teanga theagaisc agus an teanga chumarsáide idir na múinteoirí, na páistí agus bainistíocht na scoile. Cuirtear an-bhéim sa scoil ar cheol agus ar chultúr na Breataine Bige agus cuirtear béim ar leith ar dhilseacht agus grá don teanga dúchais a mhúscaill sna daltaí. Ar nós muid féin is í an Bhreatnais dara theanga formhór na ndaltaí a fhreastalaíonn ar an scoil agus tosaíonn breis is 80% dóibh ar scoil gan Breatnais ar bith.

Ysgol Morswyn Gymraeg is a Welsh 'Gaelscoil' (Ysgol Gymraeg/Welsh School) that is located near the centre of the port town of Holyhead, in Wales. The school is a Welsh language immersion school and like ourselves Welsh is the language of instruction and the language of communication amongst teachers, children & management in Ysgol Gymraeg Morswyn. The school places great emphasis on Welsh music and culture and seeks to foster and instill a love for the language and culture in the children. Like ourselves Welsh is the second language for the majority of the pupils who attend the school and over 80% of them start school without any Welsh.

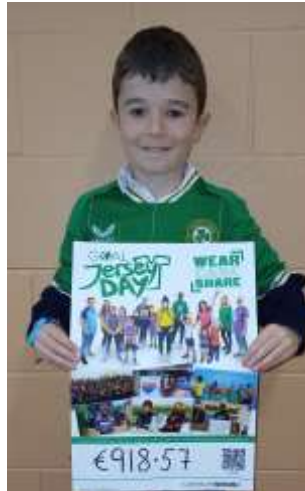


Coffee Morning

Níor cheart do charranna páirceáil díreach roimh agus tar éis na trasrianta coisithe - laistigh den scoil nó lasmuigh ar an mbóthar - tá sé seo ag tarlú ar bhonn rialta/laethúil agus tá sé ag cur ár bpáistí i mbaol.

Inappropriate and dangerous parking and driving in the vicinity of both Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille & Stepside ETNS is an ongoing problem.

The first priority for both schools is the safety of it's pupils as they walk to and from school and alight from cars.

Complaints have been received about parents blocking up the paths, driveways and roads in Belarmine and parking all over the paths around the schools.

There should be no parking/double parking in front of staff parking spaces. This is a drop and go area only. Children should be able to alight from cars and walk safely along the pedestrian corridor in front of the parked staff cars to get to the footpath.



Cars should not park up in the areas directly before and after the pedestrian crossings - either inside the school grounds or outside on the road - this is happening on a regular or daily basis and it is putting our children at risk.

Reminder: **The Rules of the Road - Parking**

It is an offence to park:

- in designated disabled persons parking spaces
- where there are white or yellow zig-zag lines on either side of zebra crossings
- 15 metres before or 5 metres after a pedestrian crossing or traffic lights;
- wholly or partly on a footpath, a grass margin, a cycle lane or track or a median strip;
- within 5 metres of a road junction unless parking spaces are clearly marked;
- The double yellow lines mean no parking at any time

N1A have started Irish dancing with Múinteoir Nuala. They are also doing lots of practice for the ‘Halloween show’ on Friday.

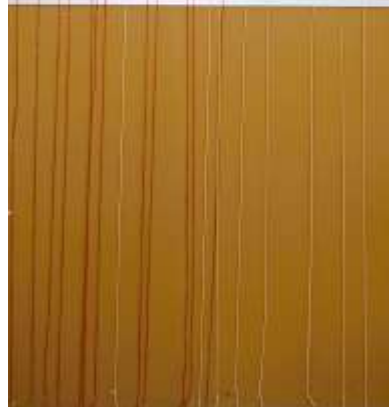


R1B Múinteoir Hannah Nic Uaid

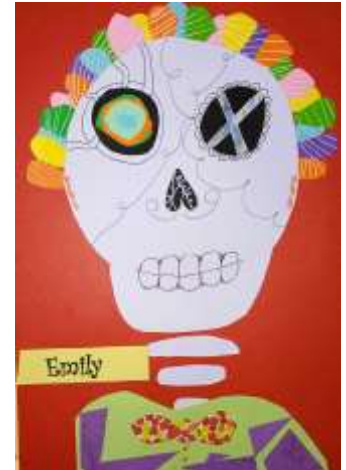

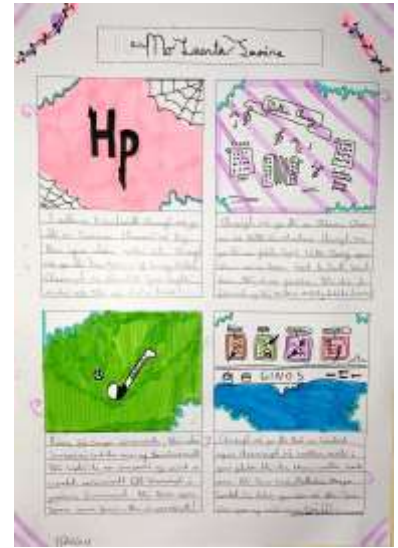

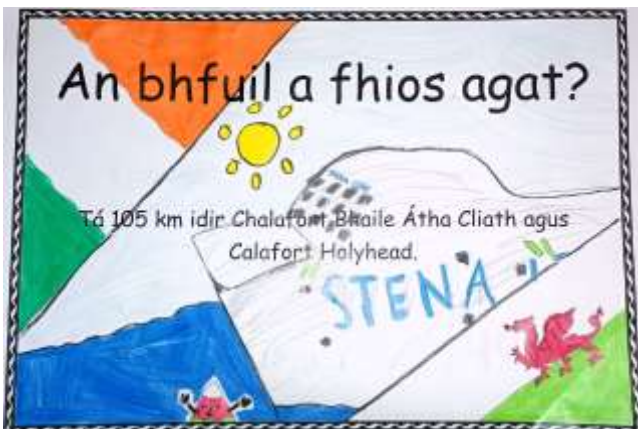
