- Scoil saor-oideachais í, a riartar le cúnamh airgeadais ón Roinn Oideachais & Scileanna. Bímid ag brath mar sin fén ar chúnamh ó thuismitheoirí agus ó chairde na scoile chun airgead a bhailíú le cuidiú le costas reatha agus forbartha na scoile.
- Is páirtneírí iad na tuismitheoirí i gcomhoideachas na bpáistí agus tá siad lán-pháirteach i gcur chun cinn agus i bhforbairt na scoile trí Chumann na dTuismitheoirí agus an Bord Bainistíochta. Grúpa tuismitheoirí a bhunaigh an scoil sa bhliain 1995. Osclaíodh an scoil ar an 4ú lá de Mheán Fómhair i gClubtheach Chumann Rugbaí de la Salle Palmerston i gCill Tiarnáin.
- I mí Márt 1998, bhronn an Roinn Oideachais & Eolaíochta aitheantas buan ar Ghaelscoil Thaobh na Coille.
- Ar an 1 Meán Fómhair 2009 bhogamar isteach inár bhfoirgneamh scoile buan in Eastáit Bheallairmín sa Chéim. Foirgneamh úr-nua, dhá-stór, 16 seomra ranga í atá geal agus fairsing le seomrai ranga móra, áiseanna cearta oideachais do na daltaí & do na múinteoirí, seomráil il-úsáide agus halla tionóil.
- Tháinig forbairt rang amháin in aghaidh na bliana ar an scoil go dtí go raibh sí ina scoil dhá shraith ionmlán sa bhliain 2016.

Fealsúnacht na Scoile

Timpeallacht shuaimhneach a chruthú ina ndéanfar cúram d'fhorbairt intleachtúil, fhisiciúil, shóisialta, mhothúchánach agus spioradálta an pháiste. An Ghaeilge mar theanga a bheith lárnach sa phróiseas foghlama, mar theanga teagaisc agus mar mheán cumarsáide. Béim faoi leith a chur ar an *gcultúr Gaelach*. Na páistí a spreagadh ina threo seo taobh istigh agus taobh amuigh den scoil. Dearcadh *dearfach* i leith na foghlama a chothú sna daltaí agus a chur ar a gcumas foghlaim neamhspléach a dhéanamh. *Atmaisféar* a chothú sa scoil a spreagann an dalta a bheith neamhspleách, caoinfhulangach, cineálta, muiníneach agus comhoibritheach. An *creideamh Caitliceach* a mhúineadh agus a chur ar fáil mar threoir mhórálta sa scoil. *Rannpháirtíocht na dtuismitheoirí* i gcomhoideachas na bpáistí a spreagadh, trí deiseanna a thabhairt dóibh a bheith lánpáirteach i gcur chun cinn agus i bhforbairt na scoile trí Chumann na dTuismitheoirí agus an Bord Bainistíochta. An *freastal céanna* a dhéanamh ar phobal uile na scoile (daltaí, múinteoirí agus tuismitheoirí) i ngach gnéith de shaol na scoile.

Introduction

- Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille is a co-educational catholic All-Irish school.
- The school functions in accordance with the usual rules of the Department of Education & Skills.
- Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille is under the Patronage of Foras Pátrúnachta na Scoileanna Lán-Ghaeilge. All children, irrespective of linguistic, social, religious background or nationality are welcome in the school.
- The school has a Catholic ethos. However we welcome children of other beliefs to our school.
- The school is a non-fee paying school which is run with the financial assistance of the Department of Education & Skills. However we do encourage parents and friends of the school to participate and support fund-raising events that supplement the costs of development and the day to day running of the school.
- Parents are seen as partners in the mutual education of their children and are very much involved in the development of the school through the Parents' Association and the Board of Management. The school was established by a group of parents in 1995. The school opened its doors on the 4th of September 1995 in the grounds of De La Salle Palmerston Rugby Club in Kilternan, Co. Dublin.
- Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille gained official recognition from the Department of Education & Science in March 1998.
- On the 1st of September 2009 we moved into our permanent school building in Belarmine Estate, Stepaside. This new two-storey, 16 classroom building is bright and spacious, has big classrooms and proper facilities for children & teachers alike, multi-purpose rooms and an assembly hall.
- The school developed one extra class a year until the school became a full two-stream school in September 2016.

School Philosophy

In Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille we strive to create *a positive learning environment* in which due regard is paid to the intellectual, physical, social, emotional and spiritual development of the child. Where the *Irish language* is central not only to the learning process, as the language of instruction but also as the language of communication amongst teachers, children, management and parents / guardians (where possible). Special emphasis being placed on all aspects of *Irish Culture* thus encouraging pupils to partake in cultural activities both inside and outside of school. To instill in the pupils a *positive attitude* towards learning thus enabling them to learn independently. *Creating an atmosphere* in the school that encourages the pupils to be independent, tolerant, kind, confident and co-operative. Teaching the *Catholic religion* and using it as a source of moral guidance in the school. Parents are seen as partners in the mutual education of their children and are encouraged to become involved in the development of the school through the Parents' Association and the Board of Management. Each and everyone involved with the school (pupils, teachers, parents) shall be treated equally in every aspect of school life.

- Chuile dheis a thabhairt do na daltaí ardchaighdeán a bhaint amach sa léitheoireacht, sa scríbhneoireacht agus sa riomhadh.
- Suímh a chruthú inar féidir leis na daltaí iad féin a chur in iúl i meáin dhifriúla – mar shampla ceol, ealaín, spórt, rince, drámaíocht srl.

Sainaidhmeanna

The Aims Of The School

In Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille we strive to provide an excellent standard of education through the medium of Irish

This will be achieved by:

- Cultivating a positive attitude and love of the Irish language and culture, in the pupils.
- Paying due regard to the development of each area of the curriculum: the languages, Irish and English; Mathematics; Social, Environmental and Scientific Education; Art Education; Physical Education; Social, Personal and Health Education; and Religious Education.
- Trying to enable the pupils to reach a high standard in Irish and in English by the time they leave the school.
- Given the pupils every opportunity to reach the highest of standards in reading, writing and arithmetic.
- Creating an environment in which the pupils can express themselves through different media - for example music, art, sport, dance, drama etc.

Specific Aims

- That the pupils will enjoy school life.
- A high standard of behaviour will be demanded. Ensuring that pupils are kind considerate and well mannered at all times to other pupils, teachers and visitors, so that there will be a positive atmosphere of co-operation in the school. (see code of behaviour)
- The development of self-confidence and self-esteem in the pupils.
- The development of good interpersonal skills.
- Placing emphasis on good listening skills, enabling the pupils to listen attentively and with consideration.
- Emphasis placed on competent and effective communication skills.
- That the pupils attain the highest standard according to their ability.

An Ghaeilge

Is í an Ghaeilge an teanga theagaisc agus an teanga chumarsáide idir na múinteoirí, na páistí, an bhainistíocht agus na tuismitheoirí / caomhnóirí (nuair is féidir é) i nGaelscoil Thaobh na Coille.

- Is teanga bheo í an Ghaeilge sa scoil laistigh agus lasmuigh de na ranganna, sa chlós agus i dtimpeallacht na scoile.
- Is í an Ghaeilge an teanga chumarsáide ag ócáidí sóisialta, ócáidí spóirt nó drámaíochta nó aon imeachtaí eile ar a bhfreastalaímid mar scoil.
- Cuirtear fáilte roimh gach páiste sa scoil is cuma cén cúlra teanga atá acu. Is i nGaeilge amháin a labhraítear leis an bpáiste nuair a thagann sé/sí ar scoil den chéad uair agus uaidh sin amach. Is é an córas luath thumoideachas ionlán atá i bhfeidhm sa scoil agus ní thosaítear ar an mBéalra a theagasc go dtí na naónáin shinsearacha.
- Iarraimid ar thuismitheoirí / chaomhnóirí agus gach duine eile a bhíonn bainteach leis an scoil cuidiú linn agus muid cruthú ‘Gaeltacht’ inár scoil agus inár dtimpeallacht.
- Molaimid go mór iarracht a dhéanamh an Ghaeilge a labhairt sa bhaile nuair is féidir, is cuma mun mbíonn ann ach an cúpla focal, nathanna cainte nó abairtí anseo is ansiúd. Is mór an chabhair dúinne agus don pháiste má bhíonn dearcadh dearfach i leith na Gaeilge le sonrú sa bhaile chomh maith leis an scoil.
- Má theastaíonn ó thuismitheoir / chaomhnóir labhairt leis an múinteoir ranga le linn ranga, iarraimid air/uirthi Gaeilge a labhairt.

An Ghaeilge

Irish is the language of instruction and the language of communication amongst teachers, children, management and parents / guardians (where possible) in Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille.

- Irish is a living language within the classroom and without, in the schoolyard, and in the vicinity of the school.
- Irish is the language of communication at social functions, sporting and drama occasions and any other activity where we are present as a school.
- All children are welcome in our school irrespective of linguistic background. Irish is the only language spoken to the child when he/she comes to school for the first time and there on after. We use the early total immersion method of language acquisition and English is not taught until senior infants.
- We ask parents and everyone who is involved with the school to help us as we strive to create our own ‘Gaeltacht’ in the school and in our locality.
- We would encourage the use of Irish at home whenever possible – it doesn’t matter if it only includes a ‘cúpla focal’, short phrases or the odd sentence here and there. A positive attitude towards Irish in the home as well as in school, is of great help to us and to the child attending our school.
- If a parent / guardian wishes to speak with the class teacher during class time, we ask that they do so “as Gaeilge”.

The pupils address the teachers by their surnames when talking to them or about them.
i.e. An Múinteoir Ní Bhroin
- Parents / guardians are asked to use this version /form of the name in front of pupils or at formal occasions. However where a parent/guardian is speaking privately or personally with a teacher first names are used.
- Parents / guardians are welcomed to the school to discuss with the class teacher or principal any difficulties or problems their child might be having. We do ask however that an appointment be made beforehand so that the teacher and parent / guardian may meet in private without being disturbed.
- If a parent / guardian has a message for the teacher or a child during class time, we ask that it be relayed “as Gaeilge”.
- Individual parent / teacher meetings are organised in the first term.
- Individual written reports are sent to the parents at the end of June.

School Hours

The school will be open for a maximum of 182 days in the year.

The school year begins on the first weekday in September.

The school closes in July and August for the summer holidays.

A list of school holidays / closures is given to parents in the first term.

The junior infants go home at 12.00 noon for the first fortnight in September.

The school will open to receive pupils at 8.50 a.m. No responsibility is accepted for pupils arriving before that time. Classes will end each day at 2.30pm, except in the case of the infant classes which finish at 1.30pm. Parents who wish to have their children escorted home should make their own arrangements to have them met at the collection point, and the person who will escort them, should be at the school not later than 2.30pm as the school cannot accept responsibility for looking after children after that time.

Attendance

Parents / guardians are required to inform the school if their child is to be absent from school.

Parents / guardians are asked to explain in writing why their child has been absent from school be it due to illness or other.

The school is required to inform the Educational Welfare Officer if a pupil is absent from school for 20 days in any school year.

No pupil will be released from school during the school day without the written permission of his/her parent/guardian.

School Lunch

We recommend that the pupils bring sandwiches, fruit and a drink to school for their lunch. Sweets, chocolate, crisps, yogurt or fizzy drinks should not be brought to school for lunch. Pupils are not allowed to share their lunches (for health reasons).

Break Times

The pupils have two breaks during the day. A ten minute break at 10.30 a.m. and a thirty minute break at 12.15. The children eat their lunch before going out to play.

School Text Books

The new free primary schoolbooks scheme introduced for the first time for the 2023/2024 school year will provide free schoolbooks for all children in recognised primary schools.

The scheme will include all schoolbooks, workbooks and copybooks.

Parents will no longer be required to make any contribution towards the cost of schoolbooks, including the cost of workbooks and copybooks.

All schoolbooks remain the property of the school and are given on loan to pupils for the duration of the school year and must be returned to the school at the end of the year.

School books are generally left in school with the exception of readers and books the pupil may need to complete his/her homework.

School Bill

A School Bill is issued for each pupil in June to cover the cost of Educational equipment & sundries not included under the Free Books Scheme.

The School Bill covers the cost of items such as Photocopying, Arts and Crafts Materials, Pupil Personal Accident Insurance and other sundries

Parents / guardians are asked to pay the 'School Bill' in June preceding the new school year.

Admission's Policy

Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille was founded to serve parents in the area who wished their children to be educated through the medium of Irish. In the allocation of school places preference is given therefore to children who are being brought up through the medium of Irish.

This Admission Policy complies with the requirements of the Education Act 1998, the Education (Admission to Schools) Act 2018 and the Equal Status Act 2000.

Admission of Students

This school shall admit each student seeking admission except where:

- the school is oversubscribed (please see section 6 below for further details)
- a parent of a student, when required by the principal in accordance with section 23(4) of the Education (Welfare) Act 2000, fails to confirm in writing that the code of behaviour of the school is acceptable to him or her and that he or she shall make all reasonable efforts to ensure compliance with such code by the student

Application for Admission

Applications for a place in junior infants will be accepted in the autumn prior to the year the child intends starting school. The relevant dates and timelines for Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille's admission process are set out in the school's annual admission notice which is published annually on the school's website at least one week before the commencement of the admission process for the school year concerned.

Admission Requirement for Junior Infants: Applicants for junior infants must be at least 4 years of age before the 1st September for the year for which they are applying.

Oversubscription

In the event that the school is oversubscribed, the school will, when deciding on applications for admission, apply the following selection criteria **in the order listed below** to those applications that are received within the timeline for receipt of applications as set out in the school's annual admission notice:

1. Children who have attained a level of fluency in the Irish language in a non-educational environment and that the said fluency would be likely to regress were the student not admitted to an Irish language school.*
2. A sibling** of an existing pupil or of a past pupil.
3. According to age; the oldest child first.

* The onus will be on parents / guardians to provide sufficient evidence to demonstrate to the board the required level of fluency in Irish. See further information in the relevant document available from the school.

** Brothers, sisters, half-sibling, foster or adopted children

The Board of Management will determine the number of children to be enrolled in junior infants on a yearly basis. The school's enrolment will be taken into consideration in taking this decision.

Bíonn daltaí Ghaelscoil Thaobh na Coille páirteach i gCór Náisiúnta na nÓg. Tionscnamh córach scoil-bhunaithe débhliantúil í Cór Náisiúnta na nÓg do dhaltaí bunscoile. Foghlamaíonn daltaí R5 & R6 clár leathan amhrán a chanann siad ansin mar chuid d'ollchór daltaí bunscoile ó B.Á.C & ar fud na tíre.

Iomáint/Peil

Tagann traenálaí iománaíochta/peile ó C.L.G. Nmh. Ólaf chun na scoile uair sa tseachtain (i rith am scoile) le traenáil iománaíochta/peile a dhéanamh leis na páistí.

Snámh

Eagraítear ceachtanna snáhma i rith am scoile mar chuid den rang Corpoideachais do dhaltaí R1 go R3. Bloc 8/9 gceacht in aghaidh na bliana a bhíonn i gceist. Bíonn costas bhrefise ar seo.

Imeachtaí iar-scoile:

Traenáil Peile/Iománaíochta

Déantar traenáil peile agus iománaíochta le daltaí ‘sna ranganna sinsearacha i ndiaidh am scoile. Glacann siad páirt i léigeanna chumann na mBunscol. Braitheann an treanáil seo go hiomlán ar dhea-thoili múinteoirí atá sásta an obair seo a dhéanamh go deonach ina gcuid ama féin.

Ceol Uirlise

Cuirtear ranganna feadóg mhór, bodhrán, bosca ceoil agus veidhlín ar fáil i ndiaidh am scoile (ó bliain go bliain).

Cúram Leanaí

Cuireann Máire de Buitléir seirbhís cúram leanaí ar fáil do pháistí atá ‘sna naónáin (1.30pm go 2.30 pm) sa naónra.

Naónraí

School activities:

Learning Support Teaching

Our learning support teachers work with pupils with Special Educational Needs or with pupils who are experiencing educational difficulties & would benefit from a bit of support with their reading or maths.

Irish Dancing

An Irish Dancing Teacher visits the school once a week to teach Irish dancing to the children. The pupils are taught class by class for half an hour each week as part of the PE curriculum. The school's Board of Management covers the cost of these lessons.

Traditional Music Band

The school has a traditional music band who come together and practice once a week during lunchtimes. This takes place under the direction and instruction of teachers who do this work in their own time.

National Children's Choir

Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille is affiliated to the National Children's Choir. The National Children's Choir is a biennial school-based choral experience for primary school children. Pupils in 5th & 6th learn a repertoire of songs which they then perform in a massed choir of pupils from all over Dublin & Ireland.

Hurling/Football

A G.A.A. coach from Naomh Ólafs comes to the school once a week (during school time) to teach hurling/football to the children.

Snámh

Swimming lessons are organised (as part of Physical Education) during school hours for the pupils of 1st to 3rd class. Each class attends a block of 8/9 lessons per year. There is a extra cost for same.

After school activities:

Football & Hurling Training

Football and hurling training for the senior pupils is carried out after school hours. The teams participate in leagues organised by Cumann na mBunscol. This training depends on the goodwill of teachers who are willing to undertake this voluntary work in their own time.

Music Tuition

Violin , flute bodhrán & button accordion classes, are organised as an extra curricular activity (from year to year).

Child Minding

Máire de Buitléir provides a child minding service for junior and senior infants (1.30pm to 2.30p m) in the naíonra.

Naíonra Thaobh na Coille

Two Irish Language playgroups operate from two prefabricated classrooms on the school grounds. The naíonraí are run independently from the school. For further information contact:
