Fóin Chliste & Gléasanna Teicneolaíochta eile: Tá úsáid fóin chliste agus teicneolaíochtaí eile ina ghné den saol laethúil do dhaoine de gach aois anois. Is féidir leo páistí bunscoile a chur i mbaol roinnt rioscaí – lena n-áirítear cibearbhulaíocht agus ábhar díobhálach. Mar fhreagairt air seo, tá sé aontaithe ag pobal na scoile seo gan fóin chliste a thabhairt dá bpáistí go dtí go mbíonn siad críochnaithe ar an mbunscoil. Comhaontú deonach is ea í seo atá faoi stiúir agus faoi threoir Chumann na dTuismitheoirí.

Uaireadóirí Cliste Os rud é gur féidir úsáid a bhaint as uaireadóirí cliste le glaoch fóin a dhéanamh, teachtaireachtaí a sheoladh agus a ghlacadh is ionann iad agus fóin póca agus tagann siad dá bhrí sin faoi na coinníallacha céanna a luaitear le fóin chliste sa pholasaí seo.

Fóin Póca: Ar mhaithe le sábháilteacht agus chun cumarsáid idir dhaltaí agus a gcuid tuismitheoirí/feighlithe a éascú roimh agus i ndiaidh am scoile, ceadaítear do dhaltaí fón póca (ní fón chliste) a thabhairt ar scoil más gá ach is gá go mbeadh an fón póca múchta go hiomlán agus coimeádta as radharc, i mála scoile an dalta. i rith am scoile, ar thuras scoile nó le linn ábhair bhreis-churaclam, agus tá siad coiscithe sa chlós & aon áit eile ar láthair na scoile.

Is féidir le daltaí gur gá dóibh teagmháil a dhéanamh leis an mbaile i rith am scoile nó tuismitheoir gur mhaith leis/leí teachtaireacht a thabhairt dá bpáiste é sin a dhéanamh tríd oifig an rúnaí ar an bhfón scoile 01 2950000.

Gléasanna Teicneolaíochta: Níl sé ceadaithe do dhaltaí gléasanna nó giúirléidí teicneolaíochta: Uaireadóir Cliste, I Pad, Táibléid, Nintendo Switch & a leithéid, a thabhairt ar scoil nó a úsáid i rith

am scoile, ar thuras scoile nó le linn ábhair bhreis-churaclam. Creidimid go dtarraingíonn gléasanna teicneolaíochta dá leithéid ó aird an dalta agus go gcuireann siad bac leis an bhfoghlaím sa suíomh scoile. Tá an polasaí scoile seo á chur i bhfeidhm leis an gcur isteach ón dteicneolaíoch neamhúdaráithe seo a mhaolú.

Mobile Phones / Technological Devices

Introductory Statement

This policy was drawn up in response to technological advances which have seen a significant increase in hand held electronic devices amongst the school population over recent years.

The following is the policy for mobile phones / electronic devices usage in the school:

Smartphones and similar technologies: The use of smartphones and other technologies is now a feature of daily life for people of all ages. They can particularly expose primary school children to a number of risks – including cyberbullying and encountering harmful content. In response to this, our school community has agreed not to give their child a smartphone until after they leave primary school. This is a voluntary agreement led and guided by the Parents' Association.

Smartwatches As most smartwatches can be used to make phone calls and send and receive text messages they are in effect mobile phones and are therefore subject to the school's mobile phone policy as stated above.

Mobile Phones (with no internet access): In the interest of safety and to facilitate communication between pupils and their parents/carers before and after school hours, pupils are permitted to bring mobile phones to school if necessary. The use of mobile phones is prohibited at all times during school hours, school tours, during extra-curricular activities and their use is forbidden in the yard or anywhere on the school grounds. Phones must be always switched off and kept out of sight in the pupil's schoolbag.

Children who need to contact home during school hours or indeed parents who need to communicate a message to their child may do so through the school secretary using the school landline 01 2950000.

Technological Devices : Pupils are not allowed bring technological devices such as smartwatches, iPads, Tablets, Nintendo Switch etc. into school or use them during school time, on school tours or

during extra-curricular activities. We believe that technological devices can be intrusive and distracting in a school environment and therefore implemented this policy to reduce the intrusiveness of unauthorized technology in our school.

Networked Devices It is important to note that all networked devices, new technology or electronic devices are subject to the school's mobile phone policy.

Breaking of the Rules Regarding Mobile Phones/Technological Devices

Any pupil breaking the school rules mentioned above will have their mobile phone/technological device confiscated and will not have it returned to them until the school day is over.

If a pupil continues to break these rules, they will be required to hand over their phone/device and parents will be asked to collect it from the school office.

This policy will be monitored on an ongoing basis and amendments added as new technology comes on stream.

Implementation

This policy was first implemented in March 2009. It was reviewed and amended in May 2025.
