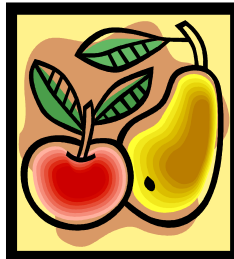


## Junior Infant Recital

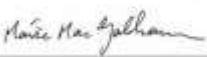
