



Abair Do Chuid - Have Your Say

Táim cinnte go bhfuil cloiste agaibh ar na meáin go bhfuil an Roinn Oideachais ag tabhairt faoi shuirbhé a dhéanamh ar thuistí a bhfuil páistí acu ag freastal ar an mbunscoil. Sé'n aidhm atá leis an suirbhé ná tuiscint a fháil ar roghanna tuistí maidir leis na bunscoileanna a bhfreastalaíonn a bpáistí orthu faoi láthair nó a bhfreastalóidh siad orthu sna blianta atá le teacht.

Cuirfear líon beag ceisteanna sa suirbhé, lena n-áireofar na ceisteanna seo a leanas:

- Arbh fhearr leat go mbeadh do bhunscoil ina scoil chomhoideachais nó ina scoil aonghnéis?
- Arbh fhearr leat go n-oibreodh do bhunscoil faoi phátrún sainchreidmheach (reiligiúnach) nó go n-oibreodh sí faoi phátrún il-sainchreidmheach (neamhreiligiúnach)?
- Arbh fhearr leat go soláthródh do bhunscoil oideachas trí Bhéarla nó trí Ghaeilge go príomha?

Is suirbhé tábhachtach é seo. Úsáidfí an Roinn Oideachais torthaí an suirbhé ina gcuid pleanála do soláthar oideachas ar an leibhéal bunscoile sa todhchaí. Seolfar gach eolas faoin suirbhé seo chugaibh ar r-phost roimh dheireadh na seachtaine. Tá sé fíor-thábhachtach mar sin go gcloistear guth na dtuistí a bhfuil a bpáistí leo ag freastal ar Ghaelscoileanna sa suirbhé seo. Is féidir tacú le deiseanna a bhronnadh ar na glúnta atá le teacht leis an nGaeilge a shealbhú trí 'oideachas trí mheán na Gaeilge' a roghnú. Iarraimid oraibh mar sin cúpla nóiméad a ghlacadh leis an suirbhé a chomhlánú.

I am sure you have heard in the media that the Department of Education is conducting a survey of parents who have children attending primary school in Ireland. The aim of the survey is to gain an understanding of parents' preferences regarding the primary schools their children currently attend or will attend in the coming years.

A small number of questions will be included in the survey, including the following:

- Would you prefer your primary school to be a co-educational school or a single-sex school?
- Would you prefer your primary school to operate under a denominational (religious) patron or to operate under a multi-denominational (non-religious) patron?
- Would you prefer your primary school to provide education primarily through the English language or through the Irish Language?

This is an important survey. The Department of Education will use the results of the survey in their planning for the provision of education at the primary school level in the future. All information about this survey will be sent to you by email before the end of the week. It is extremely important that the voices of parents whose children attend Gaelscoileanna are heard in this survey. You can support opportunities for future generations to acquire Irish by choosing 'education through the medium of Irish'. We therefore ask you to take a few minutes to complete the survey.

The pupils in R1A made pumpkins in art class before the break. They did all the cutting and designing themselves. They really looking enjoyed Halloween!

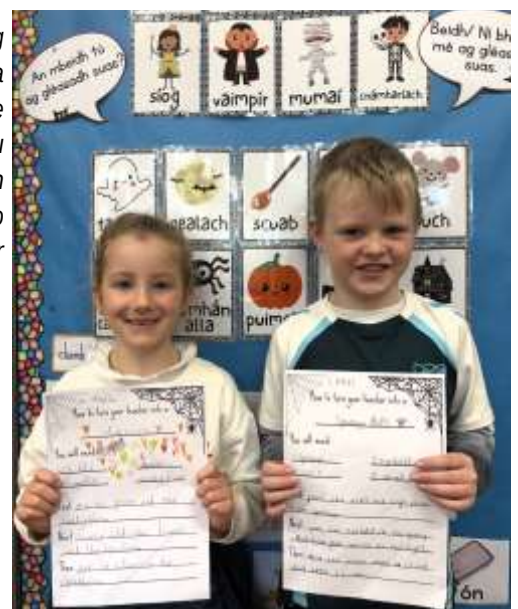


R1B Múinteoir Hannah Nic Uaid
