
Seaimpín Muay Thai

School Lunch *Reminder: We would like to remind you that the school has a healthy eating policy. We encourage the children to eat healthy foods such as fruits and vegetables as part of their school lunch. We ask the children to eat fruit and vegetables at little break with the remaining lunch being eaten at big break! We would ask you to exclude sweets, chocolate, crisps, biscuits and fizzy drinks from your child's lunchbox. We have noticed that some of these contrabands are making their way into some lunch boxes! When the hot school lunches begin in mid-January the children will need to be in the habit of eating fruit or vegetables only at 'little break' (brought in from home) and the hot lunch only after 'big break'.*
