Cé nach bhfuilimid ach díreach tar éis fáilte chun na scoile a chur roimh ár naionáin shóisearacha álainn nua, táimid anois ag glacadh le hiarratais ar Iontráil do rang na Naionáin Shóisearacha 2025/2026. Glacfar le hiarratais i gcomhair iontráil don scoilbhliain 2025/2026 ón 01/10/2024 go dtí an 25/10/2024. Is féidir iarratas a dhéanamh ar-líne tré chliceáil ar an NASC atá ar fáil ar leathanach baile suíomh gréasáin na scoile: www.taobhnacoille.ie. Cé go dtugtar tús áite sa Pholasáí ar Iontráil do shiblíni, ní féidir linn tús áite a thabhairt dóibh muna bhfuil siad cláraithe linn! Bí cinnte mar sin go gcláraíonn tú do pháiste linn roimh 25 Deireadh Fómhair, má theastaíonn uait go dtosóidh sé/sí i nGaelscoil Thaobh na Coille i Meán Fómhair 2025.

Although we have only just welcomed our wonderful new junior infant pupils to the school we are now accepting Applications for Admission for our 2025/2026 junior infant class. Applications for Admission will be accepted for the school year 2025/2026 from 01/10/2024 until 25/10/2024. On-line applications can be made by clicking on a dedicated LINK on the **home page of the school's website: www.taobhnacoille.ie**. Although priority is given to siblings in the Admissions Policy, we cannot prioritise them if they have not been registered! Please ensure that your child is registered before 25/10/2024 if you wish him/her to start in Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille in September 2025.



Tá deacracht leanúnach le páirceáil chontúirteach agus ar ghluaiseacht na tráchta thart ar Ghaelscoil Thaobh na Coille & Stepside ETNS. Is í an príomhthosaíocht don dá scoil ná sábháilteacht a ndaltaí agus iad ag siúl go dtí agus abhaile ón scoil agus ag tuirlingt as gluaiseáin.

Tá gearáin faighte cheana féin i mbliana maidir le tuismitheoirí ag blocáil na cosáin, na cabhsáin agus na bóithre i mBeallairmín agus ag páirceáil ar na cosáin i ngar don dá scoil.

Níor cheart do charranna páirceáil díreach roimh agus tar éis na trasrianta coisithe - laistigh den scoil nó lasmuigh ar an mbóthar - tá sé seo ag tarlú ar bhonn rialta/laethúil agus tá sé ag cur ár bpáistí i mbaol.

Tá an Garda Crosála lasmuigh den scoil leis an trácht a stopadh ionas gur féidir leis na páistí le cuidiú leis na páistí trasnú go sábháilte agus iad ag teacht agus ag imeacht ón scoil. Ba cheart meas a léiriú ar an obair atá á dhéanamh aici agus a bheith foighneach agus í ag crosáil na páistí go sábháilte.

Inappropriate and dangerous parking and driving in the vicinity of both Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille & Stepside ETNS is an ongoing problem. The first priority for both **schools is the safety of it's pupils as they walk to and from school and alight from cars.**

Complaints have been received already this year about parents blocking up the paths, driveways and roads in Belarmine and parking on the footpaths around the schools.

Cars should not park up in the areas directly before and after the pedestrian crossings - either inside the school grounds or outside on the road - this behaviour is putting our children at risk.

The Crossing Guard's role is to stop the flow of traffic so that the children may cross the road safely as they make their way to and from school. All drivers should be mindful of this and exercise patience and respect during periods of busy traffic.

Reminder: **The Rules of the Road - Parking**

It is an offence to park:

In designated disabled persons parking spaces
Where there are white or yellow zig-zag lines on either side of zebra crossings
15 metres before or 5 metres after a pedestrian crossing or traffic lights;
Wholly or partly on a footpath, a grass margin, a cycle lane or track or a median strip;
Within 5 metres of a road junction unless parking spaces are clearly marked;
Double yellow lines mean no parking at any time

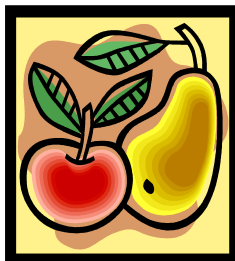


Junior Infant Recital

The girls' and boys' football teams are participating in Cumann na mBunscol competitions again this year and both teams have progressed to the knockout stages.

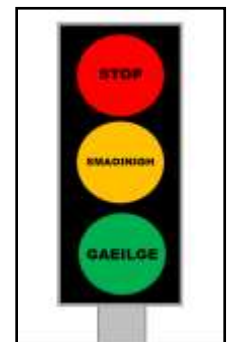

N2A Múinteoir Bernie Ní Ruadaigh

Tá N2A ag socrú isteach ina rang nua agus táimid ar fad ag cur aithne ar a chéile. Táimid ag cur an-bhéim ar labhairt na Gaeilge agus tá an-chuid rannata agus amhráin ar eolas ag na páistí cheana féin. Faigheann na páistí ard mholadh ón múinteoir agus Dojos nuair atá siad ag labhairt i nGaeilge. Táim thar a bheith sásta leis an méid Gaeilge atá á labhairt ag na páistí lena chéile sa rang agus tá na cinnirí Gaeilge ag déanamh sár-obair.

Cuirmid tús le gach lá le aireachas agus bíonn nathanna deasa á rá againn cosúil le 'Is duine cairdúil mé', 'Tá mé cliste', 'Tá grá ag daoine dom', agus 'Ní duine ar bith cosúil liomsa'. Táimid tar éis tosú ar Aistear agus tá cúig rannóg ann - drámaíocht, tógáil, ealaín, an domhan beag agus márla. Bhí 'An Scoil' mar théama againn. Tá an rang seo iontach ag tógáil le bricí agus rinne siad scoil iontach le seomraí ranga le boird agus cathaoirí, halla, agus clós na scoile.

N2A are settling into their new class and we are getting to know each other. At the moment we are placing a huge emphasis on 'Labhairt na Gaeilge' and the class know a lot of rhymes and songs. They get a huge amount of praise and Dojos for speaking as Gaeilge. I am so happy with the amount of Irish spoken by the class already.

We start each day with mindfulness listening to relaxing music and saying phrases which promote positive thinking, such as 'I am clever, 'People love me,' 'There is nobody like me'.

We have started our play through Aistear and the class are divided into groups and each group get a chance to participate in imagery play, construction, artwork, small world and marla. Our theme at the moment is 'An Scoil' and the children built a school with classrooms, furniture, hall, yard and car park!

Rang 2B are learning about autumn at the moment. Some of the children brought in examples of nature during autumn into school to share with us.





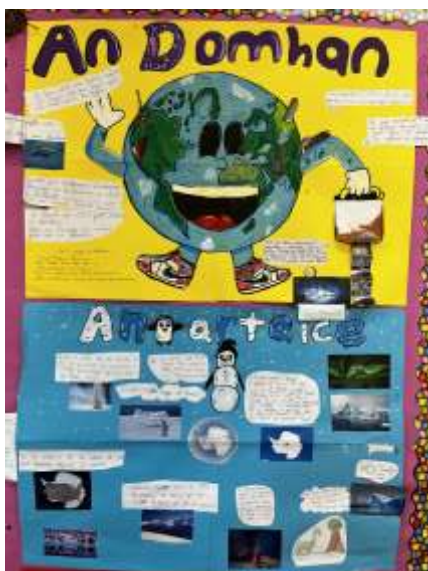
R2A Múinteoir Lauryn Bhreathnach

Can you see any 2-D shape on snails we made?

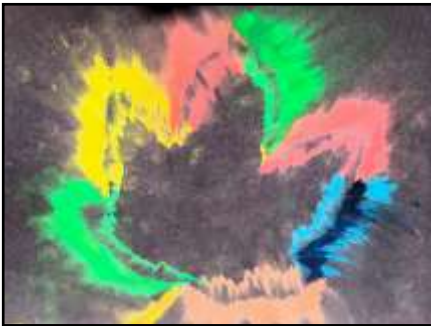
R6B Múinteoir Colm Ó Coisdealbha
