Sagart Rómhánach ab ea Vailintín a mhair sa tríú haois. Ag an am, bhí impire darbh ainm Claudius i gceannas ar an Róimh. Tugadh Claudius Cruálach ar Claudius uaireanta. Bhí baint aige le go leor cogai agus cathanna.

Bhí arm láidir ag teastáil ó Claudius chun a chuid cogai a throid. Ní raibh go leor fir ag iarraidh troid ina arm mar go gciallódh sé sin go mbeadh orthu a mná céile agus a bpáistí a fhágáil.

Tháinig Claudius suas le plean. Chuir sé cosc iomlán ar fhir pósadh. Chiallaigh sé sin nach mbeadh aon leithscéal acu gan dul isteach san arm agus troid ina chuid cogai.

Chreid Vailintín gur cheart go mbeadh daoine in ann pósadh dá mba mhian leo. Agus é ina shagart, thosaigh sé ag cabhrú le daoine pósadh faoi rún. Ar lá a fuair Vailintín bás, scríobh sé litir ag Julia agus shínigh sé 'ó do Vailintín' í. Bhí Julia in ann an nóta a léamh toisc gur leigheas Dia a daille. Fuair sé bás sé ar 14 Feabhra.

Tar éis dó bás a fháil, rinne an eaglais Chaitliceach naomh de Vailintín. Tugtar mairtíreach air. Sin duine a mharaítear mar gheall ar a gcreideamh.

Inniu ceiliúraimid Lá Fhéile Vailintín trí nótaí nó cártaí a sheoladh, bronntanais a thabhairt agus a bheith cineálta do dhaoine a bhfuil cionn againn orthu.

The Story of St Valentine

Valentine was a Roman priest who lived during the third century. At the time, Rome was ruled by an emperor called Claudius. Claudius was sometimes known as Claudius the Cruel. He was involved in many wars and battles.

Claudius needed a strong army to fight his many wars. Many men did not want to fight as that would mean they would have to leave their wives and children.

Claudius came up with a plan. He forbade all men from marrying. This meant that they would have no excuse not to join the army and fight in his wars.

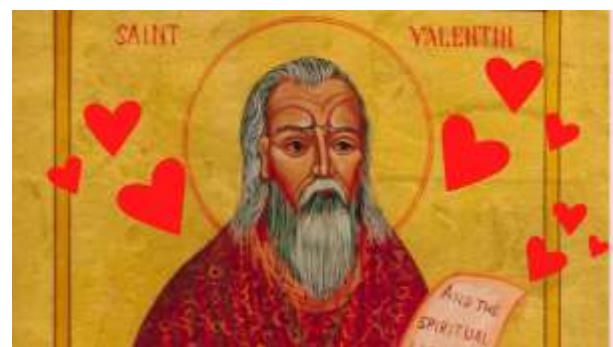
Valentine believed that people should be able to get married if they wanted to. As he was a priest, he began to help people to get married in secret, but Claudius soon found out that Valentine was marrying people in secret. He was very angry and ordered that Valentine be arrested and imprisoned.

While in jail Valentine became a teacher to his jailer's blind daughter, Julia. It is believed by many that Valentine performed a miracle when he asked God to cure Julia's blindness. After she was cured, Julia's father converted to Christianity.

On the day that Valentine died, he wrote Julia a goodbye letter and signed it from 'your Valentine'. Julia was able to read the note because God had cured her blindness. He died on the 14th of February.

After he died, Valentine was made a saint by the Catholic church. He is known as a martyr. His is somebody who is killed because of their beliefs.

Today we celebrate St. Valentine's Day by sending notes or cards, giving gifts and being kind to people we care about.

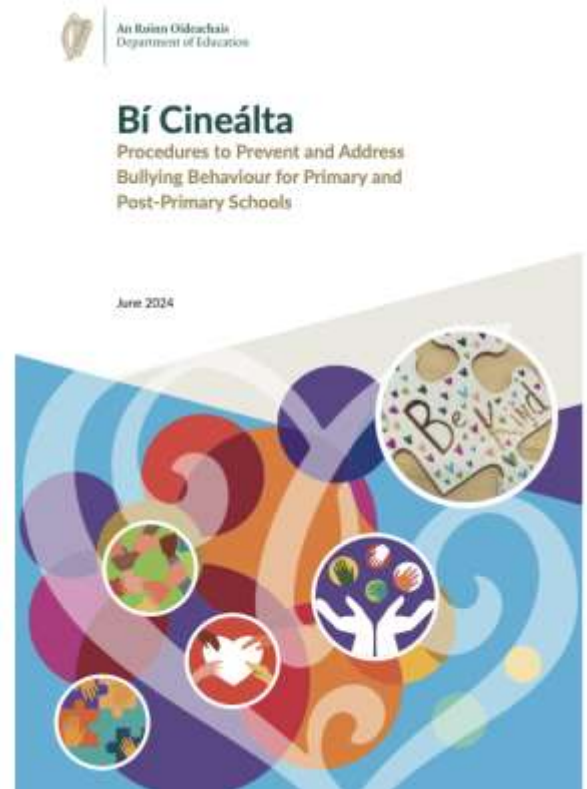
Bí Cineálta - Polasaí Nua Frithbhulaíochta New Anti-bullying Policy

Tá nósanna imeachta nua foilsithe ag an Roinn Oideachais chun bulaíocht a chosc agus dul i ngleic léi do bhunscoileanna agus iar-bhunscoileanna. Tagann na nósanna imeachta seo, ar a dtugtar **Bí Cineálta**, in ionad na nósanna imeachta frithbhulaíochta 2013 agus tiocfaidh siad i bhfeidhm ón 1 Meán Fómhair 2025.

Soláthraíonn na nósanna imeachta nua treo agus treoir do scoileanna maidir le bearta chun iompraíocht bhulaíochta a chosc.

Cé go raibh neart comhairliúcháin go dtí seo, lena n-áirítear le raon leathan páistí agus daoine óga, ar a bhfuil sna nósanna imeachta Bí Cineálta, tá Bord Bainistíochta Ghaelscoil Thaobh na Coille ag iarraidh a chinntiú go bhforbrófar agus go gcuirfear i bhfeidhm ár bpolasaí Bí Cineálta i gcomhairle lenár bpobal scoile féin, lena n-áirítear múinteoirí, páistí agus a dtuismitheoirí.

Sna seachtainí amach romhainn, tosóidh an Bord ag forbairt a bpolasaí sa réimse seo. Chun cabhrú leis an obair seo, beimid ag dul i dteagmháil libh chun bhúr dtuairimí faoin bpolasaí a phlé. *The Department of Education has published new procedures to prevent and address bullying behaviour for primary and post-primary schools. These procedures, known as **Bí Cineálta**, replace the 2013 anti-bullying procedures and come into effect from 1 September 2025.*

The revised procedures provide direction and guidance to schools, in relation to measures to prevent and address bullying behaviour in schools.

While the Bí Cineálta procedures are already informed by an extensive consultation process, including with a range of children and young people, the Board of Management of Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille is keen to ensure that our Bí Cineálta policy is developed, and implemented in consultation with our own school community, including, teachers, children and their parents.



Over the coming weeks, the Board will begin to develop its policy in this space. To assist with this work, we will be contacting parents to garner their views on the policy. A consultation session will be held in conjunction with the Parents' Association that will be made up of representatives of the parent body. If you have a particular interest in this matter and would like to attend this session please contact your class representative to inform them of same.

There is a lot of working going on in N2A and the children are enjoying it. We start the day with the activities which are set up when the children come in and they are ready to get to work as soon as they come in.

Abigail from Class 6A came to play music for the children on the Irish Flute. Finn and Thomas and P.J read a story at the junior class assembly and a lot of children are writing their own stories too.

Some children are doing a lot of extra Maths and at Thomas's suggestion I have started to give out a Maths certificate. Our Aistear theme was Bia and the class did some great work with playdough.

Our class will be taking part in the Science Blast next month in the RDS. We are busy doing various tests to clean dirty water. We have found that activated carbon and cotton wool are good at removing colour from water with paint. We used a handmade filtration waterfall system (made from Lego and cardboard) to carry out this process. Thanks to Alma, Damian's mum, who came in to give a scientific talk to the class about undertaking science experiments. The students talk about very interesting facts that they bring in for their 'Show and Tell'.

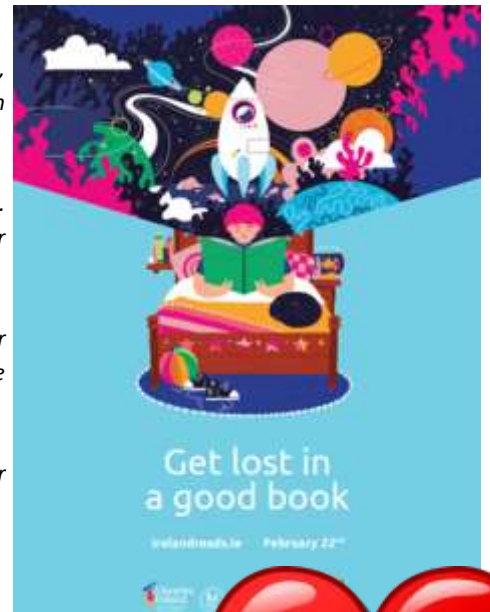
